

Pastor's Message

To The PORT,

Greetings to you in the name of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

It's four weeks into our ministry here. My family and I are having a blast getting to know this wonderful and beautiful community. We are at home. We appreciate the welcome and hospitality. Every Thursday at The PORT, I looked forward to treats from some beautiful crafting volunteers. The office has seen people stopping by to offer greetings. Thanks for the prayers and support. Thanks to the leadership, administrative, and worship teams. Thanks to everyone who goes above and beyond for The PORT. Blessings.

We are in this journey together. We are the church.

Every week at The PORT, I reflect on the children's song that says:

"The church is not a building, the church is not a steeple, the church is not a resting place, the church is a people.

I am the church, You are the church We are the church together."

We are the church together. God has called us to **BE** the church. You've probably heard the phrase, "Don't just *GO* to church, *BE* the church!"

You see, God wants us to BE the church. But what does that look like? To begin, it's important to clarify why this is a common phrase...Most people see the church as a building — a place for believers to gather (often on Sunday mornings) and worship the Lord! And when we see the church that way, we begin to misuse the word from what God had actually intended. Because when God designed "the church," He was speaking to His followers — the people — as being "the church." Not just a group of people who gather and serve Him one day a week, but believers who serve God and their communities every single day. So, to **BE** the church, where do we begin?

Know that the Holy Spirit lives within YOU!

"Consequently, you are no longer foreigners and aliens, but fellow citizens with God's people and members of God's household, built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ Jesus himself as the chief cornerstone. In him, the whole building is joined together and rises to become a holy temple in the Lord. And in him, you too are being built together to become a dwelling in which God lives by his Spirit" (Ephesians 2:19-22)

You can carry The Holy Spirit with you wherever you go. It's great to attend church to fellowship and be built up with other believers, but we don't leave the Spirit of God behind in the church building. We take Him with us so we can do what Matthew 28:19-20 tells us: "GO and make disciples."

Also please be encouraged to **BE** the church requires consistent prayer. Do not forget the A.C.T.S. Model of prayer introduced during the sermon series: A-ADORATION, C-CONFESSION, T-THANKSGIVING, S-SUPPLICATION. Prayer draws us to God. Jesus Christ consistently prays.

Welcome to the month of November. May this month work in our favor. The focus of this month is Stewardship. We will reflect on the teaching of Scott McKenzie, "Stewardship is grounded in gratitude, revealed in prayer and lived in faith."

It's Holiday Bazaar Time!

Our 47th annual Holiday Bazaar is quickly approaching on Friday and Saturday, 11/12 and 11/13. We have lots of work to get done and are counting on our PORT family to participate in as many ways as you can with your prayers, your presence, your gifts, and your service.

We are making a few changes this year for the safety of everyone, which include requiring face masks and social distancing, suspending the Bistro Kitchen food for the public, and limiting seating and gathering space in order to maintain a steady traffic flow. (Linda Schesso has generously volunteered to make a couple of hot food items that our members who are working at the bazaar can enjoy on their breaks.)

We will not be having a silent auction this year, but we are excited to bring back the Attic Treasures where used household and holiday goods will be sold out of the Wesley Room. The team behind the youth garage sale is coordinating this and will welcome lots of help with displaying and pricing that week. Exact times will be announced on Sunday, 11/7.

Please make note of the following important dates and times and, if you are able, please come for an hour or more to help.

Needed now:

- Gift Basket donations so that we can wrap them for display.
- At least one sample of each craft project being donated for sale. They can be left on the table in the bazaar room. Please include a note with your name and phone number, a description, how many you will have, approximate costs spent and a suggested selling price, if you have one.
- Take flyers with you to mail to your family and friends, or post in windows or bulletin boards at places you visit such as local stores, restaurants, hair and nail salons, bakeries, coffee shops, libraries, etc.
- The yard signs can be placed on prominent streets where they will receive lots of traffic. If you can place a few please ask Lynn or Lori Livingston. We have some regular locations and would welcome a few more. Please pick them up on Sunday, 11/14, and bring them back to church when you can.

Bake Sale Donations should be dropped off on Thursday and Friday, 11/11 and 11/12, and can be left in the kitchen. Please use the bakery trays available and follow the tips and directions on the pink handouts.

Join us for pricing of all workshop and donated craft items at 6:30pm on Mondays, 11/1 and 11/8.

Wed., 11/10, from 1pm to 5pm, set up tables and cover them, start bringing merchandise to Fellowship Hall. Heavy furniture lifting will be done so we will need strong backs and hands please!

Thursday, 11/11, from 10am to 6pm, display all merchandise, organize back-stock, decorate the room.

Friday, 11/12 – Bazaar open 9am to 6pm.

Saturday, 11/13 – Bazaar open 9am to 3pm. Teardown and clean-up from 3pm to 5pm. Heavy furniture moving required, so we need many strong backs please!

Please pray for the success of our 47th annual bazaar. This event is loved by our community and we are excited to see them again after having to move the sale online last year during Covid. Order Your Poinsettias by November 2


