## Scholarships Available from the Minnesota Annual Conference

The General Board of Higher Education and Ministry's (GBHEM) Office of Scholarships is accepting applications for the general scholarship program. If you're an active member of The United Methodist Church and you're seeking financial assistance to help pay for your education, we encourage you to apply!

Each year, we award an average of \$5.5 million to help students in the United States and abroad pursue their dreams through higher education.

Our Scholarships Department administers over 70 scholarship programs with one general application. Students are permitted to submit one application per year where it will be screened for all possible eligible programs.


