



# Road Construction Updates - 494 and Portland Ave. Bridge

### I-494 weekend closure May 30 - June 2

If you are traveling on I-494 through Richfield and Bloomington Fri, May 30 through Mon, June 2 you can expect a full closure of I-494 between Hwy 100 and Hwy 77.

Beginning 10 p.m. Fri, May 30, I-494 will be closed in both directions between Hwy 100 and Hwy 77 through 5 a.m. Mon, June 2. This weekend closure is necessary to allow crews to complete the pedestrian bridge over I-494 near Chicago Ave. and remove the Portland Ave. bridge.

Please use the following detours to bypass the closure:

Eastbound I-494 detour: Northbound Hwy 100 to eastbound Hwy 62 to southbound Hwy 77 to eastbound I-494 Westbound I-494 detour: Northbound Hwy 77 to westbound Hwy 62 to southbound Hwy 100 to westbound I-494

All ramps on I-494 between Hwy 100 and Hwy 77 will also be closed during this time. Please visit the project webpage for a full list of ramp closures and detours.

We appreciate your patience while we make these improvements. Plan ahead by checking 511 and give yourself additional time to reach your destination.

*Please note that all timeframes are approximate, subject to change, and weather and schedule dependent.* 

# More about this project

We are constructing E-Z Pass lanes from Hwy 100 to I-35W in each direction and adding a new ramp at the I-35W and I-494 interchange. We are also replacing the bridges crossing over I-494 at Portland Ave., Nicollet Ave., and 12th Ave., and adding a new pedestrian bridge at Chicago Ave.

Motorists can expect lane, ramp, overnight and weekend directional closures along I-494 and I-35W at various times for construction through 2026. There will also be some lane and road closures on local roadways near I-494.

When work is completed, the E-Z Pass lanes and the new ramp at the I-35W and I-494 interchange will address congestion on the interstate. The new bridges at Portland, Nicollet, and 12th Ave. will accommodate future traffic levels, provide wider, accessible sidewalks, new bike lanes, and upgrades to some transit stations. We will be removing access to I-494 from Nicollet Ave. and 12th Ave., but will provide full access to I-494 from Portland Ave.

NOTE: According to the project website, Portland Avenue access to 494 will be closed until the end of October.

#### Feathered Miracles of New Life from our Courtyard!

Every spring we can count on finding a family of ducks in our courtyard. This year we discovered them on May 6th, and there were 15 babies! We called Bloomington's Animal Control to help us gather them up and get them safely across Portland Avenue so they could make their way to the pond at Smith Park. But thankfully all of the babies were found and transported in a crate, and then released back into momma's care. A big thanks to Kathy Soucy (aka our "duck whisperer") for coming to help Officers Alisa and Another successful brood! John. It took them all about 2 hours of patience and persistence.
